

SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT IN CENTRAL PUBLIC SECTOR ENTERPRISES (CPSEs)

(as per Sustainable Development Guidelines, DPE, Ministry of Heavy Industries & Public Enterprises (Sept. 2011))

Engineering Staff College of India (ESCI) and Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) with cooperation from Department of Public Enterprises (DPE), Ministry of Heavy Industries and Public Enterprises conducted a training programme on Sustainable Development in Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs), from 25-26 July 2012 at Hotel Taj Vivanta, Begumpet, Hyderabad. The programme was inaugurated by Shri J.R. Panigrahi, Director, DPE. Cdr. A.K. Poothia IN (Retd), Director General, Engineering Staff College of India; Dr. Shalini Sharma, Head, Centre for Climate Change, Engineering Staff College of India and Brig. (Retd) M N Venugopal, VSM, Chief (A&P), Engineering Staff College of India attended the inaugural function in addition to the participants.

22 participants attended from various organisations namely Bharat Heavy Electrical Limited, Tiruchirappalli; Chennai Petroleum Corporation Limited, Chennai; Darashaw & Co Pvt Limited, Mumbai; Ferro Scrap Nigam Limited, Bilai (C.G); Housing and Urban Development Corporation, New Delhi; Jindal Steel & Power Limited, New Delhi; Mahanadi Coal Fields Limited, Orissa; NTPC Limited, Noida; NHDC Limited, Bhopal; PEC Limited, New Delhi, THDC India Limited, Rishikesh, Visakhapatnam Steel Plant, Visakhapatnam.

OBJECTIVE

The objective of this course was to enable the Companies/ Industries & Organizations to learn & implement the "Guidelines on Sustainable Development for CPSEs" issued by the Department of Public Enterprises, Ministry of Heavy Industries & Public Enterprises Government of India.

Following sessions were taken by different faculty during the programme:

- Director, DPE took session on Scope of GOI Guidelines for Sustainable Development & Policy and Planning.
- Faculty from GIZ took sessions on (i) Waste Management, Water Management, Energy Management and (ii) Material & Natural Resource Management
- DNV faculty took session on (i) Carbon Management & Supply Chain and (ii) Sustainable Development (SD) Reporting & Training
- Faculty from DPE took sessions on (i) Project Evaluation and (ii) Reporting (Filling up Target Setting cum Evaluation Template and Mark/ Weight Allotment Procedure)

- Faculty from Wildlife Institute of India took session on Biodiversity Conservation – Related Laws and Regulations
- ESCI faculty also took sessions on (i) Life Cycle Analysis; (ii) Implementation and Operation and (iii) Monitoring and Review (Internal Audit Verification, Management Review etc.)


FEEDBACK

The overall rating for the programme was 4.71 on the scale of 5 which indicates that the programme was very good (where 1= Poor; 2= Below Satisfactory; 3= Satisfactory; 4= Good and 5= Excellent).

There was a specific suggestion from participants stating that the companies want to do this programme at their site, for supervisor level of employees. They also suggested that training programme days need to be increased to three (3).

DPE officials who came to take sessions during training programme collected inputs about non-clarity/ problematic points in “Guidelines for Sustainable Development for CPSEs”. DPE officials will use these points for revising the policy.

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
